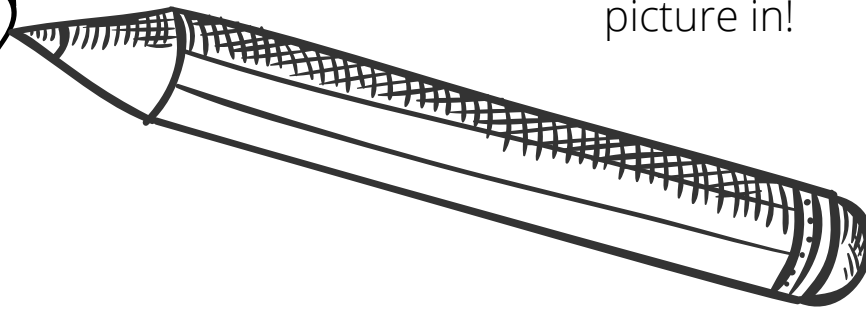


LOST LIMBS

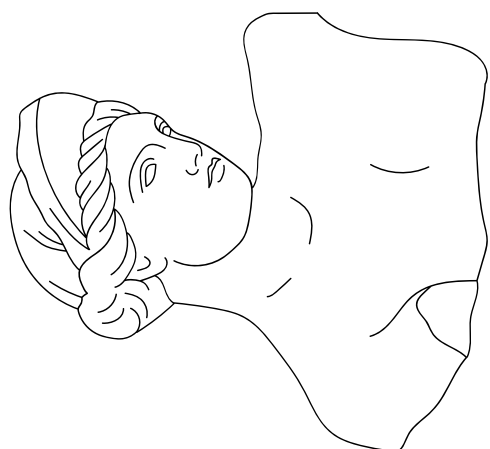
Statues from ancient Greece and Rome are thousands of years old! Because of this, most of them are found missing a few pieces.

over 2000 years ago.

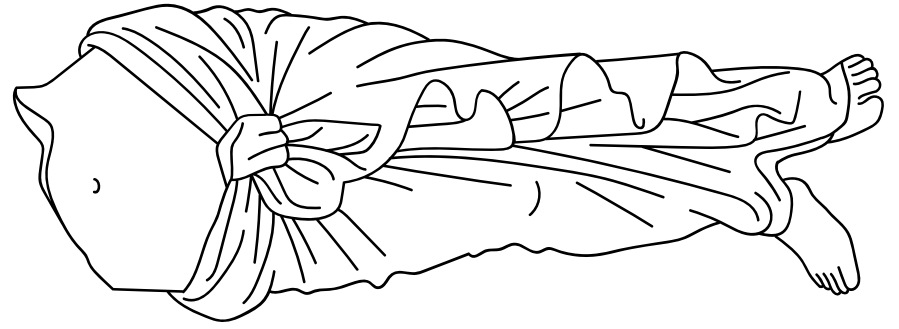
Aphrodite was the ancient Greek goddess of love and

Nike of Samothrace is an original ancient Greek statue that is over 2000 years old.

Nike was the Greek goddess of victory, which is why this statue is also known as the Winged Victory.



This statue is of Hermes and the baby Dionysus
- it was made by the famous sculptor Praxiteles
2300 years ago.

Hermes was the messenger god and a
protector of travellers, while Dionysus was the
god of wine and theatre.
